


IMPORTANT: These instructions only apply to Web Store 2.0.

1 Login to PayPal.

Use paypal.com for a live account, or sandbox.paypal.com if you are testing.

2 Click Profile.

You will see a page like this:

3 Click Website Payment Preferences.

Confirm that all options are set to "Off".

4 Click Back to Profile Summary, and then click Instant Payment Notification.

5 Turn on IPN

Type the notification URL as your Web Store URL followed by

`/xls_payment_capture.php`

For example, if you type `http://www.mywebstore.com` into your web browser to access your Web Store, the notification URL would be:

`http://www.mywebstore.com/xls_payment_capture.php`
